

ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Receiver Maria M. Yip's Second Unopposed Motion to Extend Receivership (the "Motion") [ECF No. 161], filed on April 22, 2026. Ms. Yip requests an additional six months to extend the receivership in this case in order to prosecute a fraudulent transfer action against Defendant Masri and his parents. [*Id.* ¶¶ 5–7]. The Motion is reasonable.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Motion [ECF No. 161] is **GRANTED**. The receivership in this matter, as set forth in the Court's August 26, 2025, Stipulated Order for Permanent Injunction and Monetary Judgment as to Defendants William Holton and Ecom Direct LLC [ECF No. 148], Stipulated Order for Permanent Injunction and Monetary Judgment as to Defendants Jason Masri, Automation Industries LLC, and Click Profit Distribution, LLC [ECF No. 149], and Stipulated Order for Permanent Injunction and Monetary Judgment as to Defendants Click Profit, LLC, M23 Holdings, LLC, SA Automation Enterprise LLC, M7 Investments LLC, Express Ecom LLC, Craig Emslie, and Patrick McGeoghean [ECF No. 151], is hereby extended by six months, **through and including October 23, 2026**.
